

Ray Pinkham, Former Student at Varsity, Dies At Denver, Colo.

Ray C. Pinkham, formerly a student at the state university, died Friday from tuberculosis in a military hospital at Denver, Colo., according to word received here today.

Mr. Pinkham was born in Absaroka, N. D. He graduated from the state university in 1912, and practiced law at Killdeer, Dunn county. When the war broke out he joined the American army and served in France. It was there he contracted the disease which caused his death.

He is survived by one sister, Miss Marguerite Pinkham, of Fargo, and one brother, Sherman Pinkham, of Washington. Both were with him at the time of his death.
