I'm looking for any information about my great grandparents, Arthur and

Mary Ann (went by Annyie Maud) Noice MAINWARING. They came from London, Ontario, Canada about 1888 or a year or two later. I do know that they lived in Hyde Park at one time as I have a summer school roster with the names of my grandfather and his sister--Ralph Mainwaring and Alice Mainwaring (actually Dorothy Alice).

I am unable to discover anything about what happened to either of my great grandparents--I understand that Arthur MINWARING died when my grandfather (Ralph) was about 5 so that would make the year about 1902. I don't know where either of them died or if my great grandmother remarried.

Annie Maud (Mary Ann) was the daughter of John and Mary Dickey NOICE who lived in the Walhalla area. I know that those two are buried in the Walhalla cemetery (Hillside or Hillcrest?)

My grandfather, Ralph MAINWARING went to North Dakota Agricultural College about 1907 and was in the Cadet or Military Band--but I think his address still showed Hyde Park as his hometown.

Is there a way to discover when and maybe where this family lived? I'm mostly interested in learning what happened to them. In Canada Arthur MAINWARING was a marble cutter and stonemason. He may have been a member of the Masons--I know that my grandfather, Ralph, was. Thank you for any assistance you might be able to give. Linda Swanson :)
